MARKS GRADE

(i) "Marks Grade" module help you to define grade for marks.

As per CCE (Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation) there a pattern used to display grade in place of marks. "**Marks Grade**" helps to assign **grades** in place of **marks**.

Example;-

Percentage of Marks	Grade
90-100	A+
70-89	А
50-69	B+
30-49	В
0-29	С
Above 70	A+
Below 70	A

For example, if the SA1 conducted for a maximum of 100 marks and the student has scored 80 then percentage of marks is 80 % and corresponding grade would be "A". If FA1 is conducted for maximum of 25 marks then percentage of marks is 80% and subject grade is "A".
