## Marks Grades

## MARKS GRADE

(i) "Marks Grade" module help you to define grade for marks.

As per CCE (Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation) there a pattern used to display grade in place of marks. "Marks Grade" helps to assign grades in place of marks.

Example;-

| Percentage of Marks | Grade |
| :---: | :---: |
| $90-100$ | $\mathrm{~A}+$ |
| $70-89$ | A |
| $50-69$ | $\mathrm{~B}+$ |
| $30-49$ | B |
| $0-29$ | C |
| Above 70 | $\mathrm{A}+$ |
| Below 70 | A |

For example, if the SA1 conducted for a maximum of 100 marks and the student has scored 80 then percentage of marks is $80 \%$ and corresponding grade would be "A". If FA1 is conducted for maximum of 25 marks then percentage of marks is $80 \%$ and subject grade is " $A$ ".
